Scriptures unarguably show, "I AM" is The Almighty Father. (Exodus 3:13-14)

YAH-shua says something *very important* in John 8:24 that *all* people should heed.

"Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am (*He*), you will die in your sins."

Notice the *(He)* in this verse is in italics, which means that it was not in the original Greek, but was <u>added</u> by the translators. The *(He)* in italics was **NOT** spoken by Yahshua. This added word completely obscures the fact that Yahshua was claiming to be the great "I AM", The Almighty Father of Exodus 3:14.

The Greek words translated as "I am" are 'EGO EIMI' which is: "I AM".

John 8:24 is actually as follows,

"Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for <u>if you do not believe</u> that I AM, you will die in your sins."

What YAH-shua tells us is clear and unambiguous, it is not open to more than one interpretation. His message is this, "if you do not believe that I AM, you will die in your sins." Yahshua makes it crystal clear that for a person to be saved from sin, they must believe that He is I AM, The Almighty Father of Exodus 3:14.

Why must this be?

The answer is simple. It is because The Almighty
Father, as Scripture states, is the only Savior!

(Isaiah 43:11; Isaiah 45:21; Hosea 13:4)
He is the only one that can save someone from their sins. There is no other Savior! Therefore, if a person does not believe Yahshua MessiYah is I AM (The Almighty Father and only Savior) they will be lost and die in their sins.

Thirty four verses later in John 8:58, Yahshua <u>emphatically</u> repeats His declaration that <u>He</u> is I AM, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh.

"Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."

Today, people engage in intellectual debates about who the Father is. Is our Savior the Father, is our Savior a second person in the Trinity Doctrine?

But Yahshua is having none of it, He speaks clearly and truthfully to those who will listen. He is I AM, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh and no debating or intellectualizing will change that. No man, tradition or denomination will change that.



The Almighty Father tells us in Isaiah 43:11 "there is no other Savior but Me."

The Almighty Father manifested Himself in flesh as a man, to do <u>for us</u> what we could <u>NEVER</u> do for ourselves. He fulfilled the demands of the Law as a perfect man of flesh, so that <u>He</u> could be <u>our perfect</u> sacrifice and 'kinsman-redeemer'!

On the cross He took <u>ALL</u> of our sins (past, present and future) and put them upon <u>Himself</u>, paying <u>our</u> price and thereby making us "holy, blameless" and "without a single fault" in His eyes. (Colossians 1:22)

This is the gospel! This is the Good News!

Salvation is a gift for you

Salvation is a **gift** we receive when we call upon Yahshua MessiYah, *The Almighty Father manifested in flesh*. The **gift** of salvation cannot be **earned** by our deeds, works or fruitless *self-righteous* attempts at 'keeping the Law'. We cannot obtain it by being a "good person" or by attending church.

We can only receive our salvation <u>as a gift</u> from Yahshua MessiYah... *to us*.

Everyone who calls upon the name of Yahshua will be saved, so call upon Him now. Tomorrow is not assured.

There is only <u>one</u> King in The 'Kingdom of God' - The Almighty Father

The Scriptures <u>clearly</u> say that **The Almighty Father** is our **King**.

The Scriptures <u>clearly</u> say that **Yahshua MessiYah** is our **King**.

Does the 'Kingdom of God' have two Kings?

No, The Almighty Father is our only King.

The apostle Paul gives us understanding.

Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians 8:6, "for us there is one God, the Father."

Paul tells us in Ephesians 4:6 there is "one God and Father of all."

Paul, then tells us our "one God, the Father", manifested Himself in flesh.

"God was manifested in the flesh" 1 Timothy 3:16

(Notice that Paul <u>does not say</u>, Gods 'son' was manifested in the flesh.)

The Apostle Paul knew Yahshua MessiYah was The Almighty Father manifested in flesh because he used Old Testament Scriptures which spoke of The Almighty Father and applied those Scriptures directly to Yahshua MessiYah.

Romans 10:13 referencing Joel 2:32

- 1 Corinthians 1:31 referencing Jeremiah 9:24
- 1 Corinthians 2:16 referencing Isaiah 40:13
- 1 Corinthians 10:26 referencing Psalm 24:1
- 2 Corinthians 10:17 referencing Jeremiah 9:24

Paul says this of Yahshua MessiYah in Titus 2:13

"looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great **God** and Savior Jesus Christ" (Yahshua MessiYah)

Zechariah's prophecy – The King will ride into Jerusalem on a donkey

"Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.

Zechariah 9:9

Zechariah's prophecy fulfilled -Yahshua MessiYah enters Jerusalem riding on a donkey. (Matthew 21:1 – 21:11)

"All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying:
"Tell the daughter of Zion,
"Behold, your King is coming to you,
Lowly, and sitting on a donkey,
A colt, the foal of a donkey."

Matthew 21:5



The Almighty Father says He will be pierced

"And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced."

The Almighty Father ... Zechariah 12:10



This prophecy, regarding "whom they pierced" is remarkable because it is The Almighty Father *Himself* speaking.

The Almighty Father says clearly,

"they will look on Me whom they pierced"

It was Yahshua MessiYah, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh who was pierced.

The <u>invisible</u> Father manifested <u>Himself</u> in flesh as <u>our MessiYah</u> to <u>fulfill</u> 'the Law' on <u>our</u> behalf, and to <u>shed His blood for us</u> as <u>our</u> atoning sacrifice.

In Acts 20:28, The apostle Paul tells the church elders in Ephesus...

"Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood."

Acts 20:28

It is important we understand the meaning of these names

YAH YAHWEH YAHSHUA Are names of The Almighty Father

YAH - is the Almighty Father's name. (Psalm 68:4; Isaiah 12:2; (in Revelation 19:1-6 The people are shouting HalleluYAH!)

YAH-weh - is the Almighty Father's name with a 'descriptor' added. The descriptor 'weh' means, 'The Self-Existent one' (I AM). YAH-weh means, 'YAH - The Self-Existent one'.

YAH-shua - In the New Testament, YAH now combines His name with His <a href="https://nichambe.nichambe

We see from Paul's scriptures and Zechariah's fulfilled prophesies that **The Almighty Father YAH**, manifested <u>Himself</u> in flesh to become our Savior, <u>YAH</u>shua the MessiYah. The *identity* of our Savior is **found** in our Savior's Name! (<u>YAH</u> is Salvation)

The Scriptures <u>clearly</u> say that The Almighty Father is our King.

The Scriptures <u>clearly</u> say that **Yahshua MessiYah** is our **King**.

Now, we understand why. It is because The Almighty Father is Yahshua MessiYah manifested in flesh!

Many fail to comprehend that **The Almighty Father** can be in Heaven filling the universe with His majesty and yet, at the same time, He can manifest His glory among us in the tent of a human body... Yahshua MessiYah!
