

## The 'Trinity Doctrine' and the 'Trinitarian god'

There is nothing more important than knowing The Almighty. He has **revealed Himself** to us in His Word. The Bible tells in both the Old and New Testament that The Almighty is a **singular one**. (Deu 6:4; Mark 12:28)

Our Savior **Himself** tells us this in Mark 12:28,

*And one of the scribes... asked Him, What commandment is the first of all? Yahshua answered, The **first** is, Hear O Israel, Yahweh is our Elohim, **Yahweh is one.***

The Catholic church formulated the '**Trinity Doctrine**' at the Councils of Nicaea and Constantinople centuries after Yahshua and the Apostles lived. **Disregarding** our Savior's words, they came up with a radically **different 'god'** from The Almighty God we see in Scripture. The resultant '**trinitarian god**' was '**one entity**' which was comprised of '**three distinct persons.**'

In the Bible however, The Almighty is **never** referred to as an '**entity**'. In fact, you will not find the word '**entity**' in the Bible. Furthermore, **not one** of the inspired writers of the Bible has ever told us The Almighty is **comprised of three distinct persons.**

The Catholic church acknowledged the 'Trinity Doctrine' was revealed to them, **not in the Bible, but by revelation... and Catholic tradition.**

The Catholic Church states that **Catholic Tradition**, is as **equally** important as the Holy Scriptures. They state that both "**Tradition**" and "Sacred Scripture" are sources of divine revelation for the Catholic church.

*"Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture, then, are bound closely together, and communicate one with the other."*

(Vatican, II. The Relationship Between Tradition And Sacred Scripture)

## The Protestant Church and the 'Trinitarian god'

The '**Protestant church**' adopted the 'Trinity Doctrine' *as their own*, at the time of the '**Protestant Reformation**' in the 16th century.

The New International Encyclopedia states,

***“At the time of the Reformation, the Protestant Church took over the doctrine of the Trinity (from the Catholic church) without serious examination.”***

When Protestant churches lift up the '**Trinity Doctrine**', they are lifting up the '**Trinitarian god**' at the same time.

Let us remember that it was **Jewish Believer's** who founded the Christian church (Yahshua, Paul and the Apostles). The bedrock of Judaism has always been strict monotheism - the belief that The Almighty is a singular One.

What repels Jewish Believer's from both Catholics and Protestants is '**Trinitarianism.**' The Jewish people have always safeguarded their monotheism against **Trinitarian proselytizing**. To them, the Catholic and Protestant '**Trinity Doctrine**' is blasphemous, for they believe the '**trinitarian god**' to be a **different god** than The Almighty God of Scripture.

How can Jewish Believers (or any Believer) accept the **trinitarian god** who is '**one entity**' consisting of '**three distinct persons**', when this **refutes the Scriptures** and the very words of **The Almighty Himself?**
